Vanessa Louise Dunzik was committed to addressing hunger and food insecurity in New Brunswick. She was a founding member of the Feeding New Brunswick Network. Vanessa's Food Pantry at Emanuel Lutheran Church was named in honor of her dedication to her service in feeding the hungry. In 2019, she received ShopRite's Hunger Hero award.

Vanessa was a special member of our MOWGNB family. A board member since 2017, she was a tireless advocate for our clients and made valuable contributions to committees including Personnel, Fundraising and Emergency Planning. Her creative spirit sparked the re-design of our brochure.

Earlier this year, Vanessa died at the age of 57, surrounded by her family. She is survived by her three children and many other family members. She is greatly missed.

Helen Burd-Outstanding Volunteer

Helen Burd began volunteering shortly after the program started in 1973, having served in many roles, including kitchen coordinator, volunteer delivery person, Director and Board member. Helen is our longest serving volunteer at 50 years and counting.

Mayor James Cahill–Civic Support Award

James M. Cahill is the 62nd Mayor of the City of New Brunswick. A lifelong City resident, he has served continuously as Mayor since 1991. OUR 50 YEAR HISTORY

In the fall of 1972, following a program sponsored by the American Red Cross on Food for the Elderly, community organizations in New Brunswick recognized a need and created Meals on Wheels in Greater New Brunswick to deliver meals to homebound elderly. The members of the planning committee were Edna May Hirschman, Mary Keithler, Grace Evans, Jeff Murray, Janet Price, Don Higgins, Norman Boggs, Maxine Gatling, and others.

Initial funding was provided by The New Brunswick Mutual Foundation. The American Red Cross, Saint Peter's General Hospital (now Saint Peter's University Hospital) and Middlesex County General Hospital (now Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital) were the three sponsoring agencies for the new organization. New Brunswick women's groups provided staffing, with volunteers coming from Church Women United, National Council of Jewish Women, the National Council of Negro Women, the Visiting Nurses Association, 20 churches and synagogues, the County Medical Society Auxiliary, nine United Fund organizations and five county and city government agencies.





With Saint Peter's University Hospital preparing the food, volunteers delivered the first meals on April 16, 1973 to eight clients. In 2009, MOWGNB contracted with Promise Catering, a program of Elijah's Promise in New Brunswick, to prepare our meals as part of their culinary school. In 2022, Meals on Wheels contracted with EU'S Catering in Somerset for our meals.

We now have well over 125 unique clients per year, and we deliver over 33,000 meals each year (5 days a week). Our primary mission has always been to provide nutrition to the homebound elderly residents of New Brunswick and Highland Park. We have recently expanded the service to deliver shelf-stable emergency food for snow and hurricane days, fresh fruits and vegetables from a local farmers market, household cleaning products, and personal care items. Under a special grant, we are delivering meals to younger disabled or homebound adults who would not ordinarily be eligible for our services. We are currently funded by government and private grants and private donations.

We have had a number of wonderful program directors over the years. Edna May Hirschman was the first, serving for 15 years. She was follwed by Helen Burd, Janet Price, Joan Casarella, Dana Andrews, and Helena Monroe. Shareka Fitz was hired as Program Director in 2008 and in 2018 became our first Executive Director, a role in which she currently serves with distinction. In addition to Shareka, we have one part-time employee, Monica Khetarpal.



Our Board of Directors is hands on, providing many services that would ordinarily be a drain on financial resources. James Horvath is our longest serving member, and he has been on the Board since 1987.

Since 1973, volunteers have contributed generously of their time. We have many weekly and monthly volunteers, as well as corporations such as the Hyatt and Johnson and Johnson, who have supported their staff as volunteers over the years. We have partnered with multiple social service organizations to provide volunteer opportunities for adults with developmental delays. Currently, more than 80 volunteers, community organizations, and Rutgers University students deliver meals. Helen Burd is our longest serving volunteer and has been delivering meals for 50 years and counting.

The hard work of our staff and volunteers have allowed many elderly and homebound residents of New Brunswick, Highland Park, and the surrounding area to continue living independently. Over the past 50 years, we have served over one million meals, and we hope to serve many more.
